How to select attendant control

Feature	VR2 Dual 	R-net Dual 	R-net CJSM / CJSM2 
Taking control / giving back	Push-button exchange between user & attendant	Push-button exchange between user & attendant	No handover button — control belongs to whoever powers on
Driver speed	Independent: attendant can set their own speed limit	Usually carries over from the user when swapped (depends on programming)	Independent: attendant can set their own speed limit
Ergonomics at push-handle	Compact Dual Attendant Module — light, easy to mount	Compact Dual Attendant Module — light, easy to mount	Bulky, heavier, with cables and screen inverted
On/Off button (attendant side)	No dedicated on/off	No dedicated on/off	Has on/off button
Seat/actuator controls	Yes — attendant can operate seating functions	Yes — attendant can operate seating functions	Yes — full seating menu, but more complex to navigate
Feedback to caregiver	Simple LED indicators	Simple LED/status indicators, Focus icon shows who is in control	Full LCD screen with status, modes, profiles
